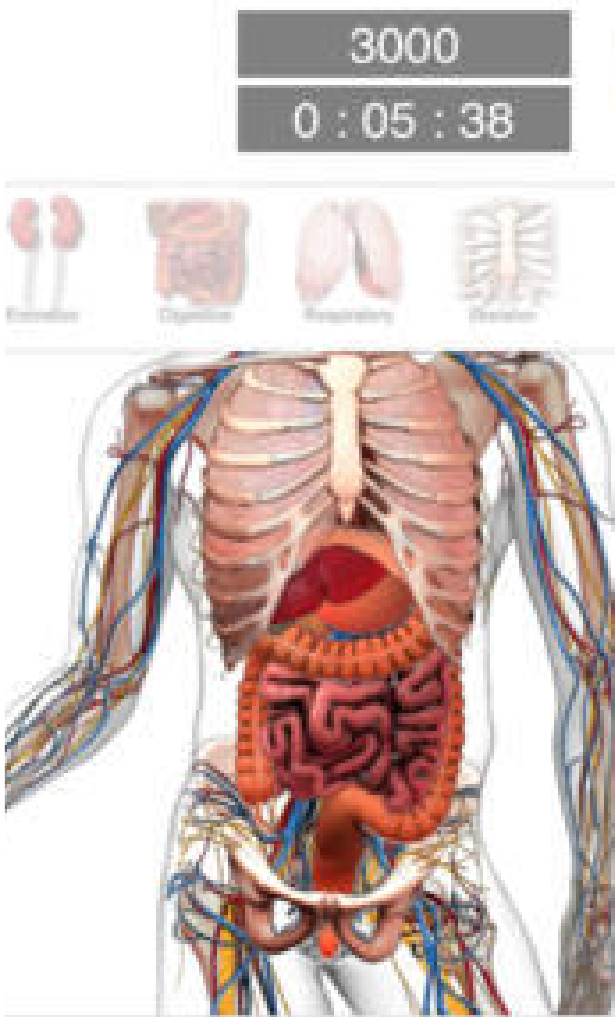
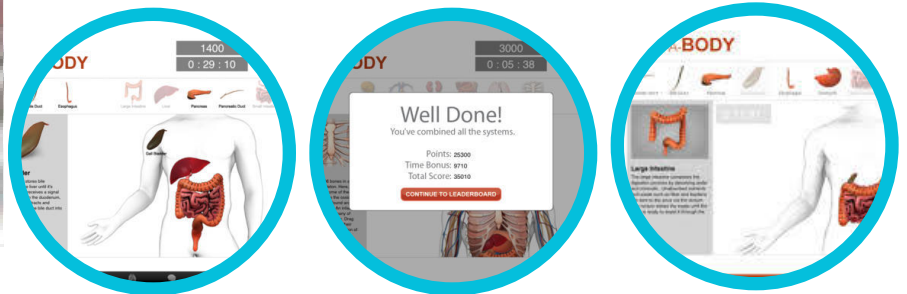


# Build A Body

## Learn About Body Systems



The Build A Body app is an excellent one for learning about or reviewing the main systems of the human body. Students can select a system to work on, and must drag and drop the organs of that system into the correct places. The app times how long it takes to complete each system. Students are also given information about each item they add to their systems. You can select from the following systems: digestive, respiratory, skeletal, nervous, excretory, and circulatory. ## Classroom Connection

This app is a great way to visualize the different systems of the body. Use it as an introduction to a unit, or as a review before a test.
