
This sticker costs \$2.6





Practice Adding Money



The Sticker Shop app is a fun way for students to practice adding money. In this simple app, they browse the sticker book for images that they like. Once selected, the app takes them to the main screen where they find out how much their sticker costs. They need to drag coins (pennies, nickels, dimes, and guarters) from the bottom onto the counter to add up to the cost of their sticker. If they get it correct, the sticker goes in their personal sticker book. If they get it wrong, it goes back to the main sticker book and they can try again. It's a good app for basic money counting practice, but my one complaint is that there doesn't seem to be a way to remove coins from the counter if you make a mistake and want to fix it.







Classroom **Connection**

This app can be used as a reinforcement and review tool in your money unit. Challenge students to buy multiples of the same sticker, but see how many different ways they can come up with the correct amount.
